Asthma, a sickness of the lung sometimes causing health problems and even death, is rising, especially among children. Because air pollution has also been increasing over the past few years, a relationship between air pollution and asthma has already been well-known. However, more recent studies show that air pollution is not the only cause of increasing asthma. Surprisingly, babies in their first year exposed to cockroaches, herbicides, and pesticides showed a higher rate of growing asthma by their fifth birthday than babies who were not so exposed. Those exposed to cockroaches were twice as likely to get the situation. Herbicides and pesticides claimed higher tolls at 4.6 and 2.4 times, respectively. Doctors who had studied 700 children said that exposure to **the three sources** after one year old also caused more asthma attacks, but slowly than for newborn babies. This difference was because of the rapid growth of the lungs during the first year of life.
